Key Responsibilities

- Operate in-house print equipment including wide-format printers, direct-to-film (DTF) printers, direct-to-object printers, and heat presses.
- Assist with preparing digital files for production, including sizing, layout checks, and basic color adjustments.
- Support production runs from setup to finished product, ensuring consistency and accuracy.
- Perform basic equipment cleaning, upkeep, and routine maintenance tasks.
- Monitor print quality and flag issues before products move to the next stage.
- Assist with inventory management, including counting, tracking, and purchasing apparel and products.
- Help track and restock consumables such as inks, films, substrates, and blanks.
- Work closely with the design, sales, and production teams to meet timelines and priorities.
- Assist with trimming, finishing, packaging, labeling, and preparing orders for pickup, shipping, or events.
